News from SID

Meetings are held 3rd Tuesday of every month at the Sherriff Office on 84th and Platteview. The meeting times may be changing after the first of the year to every other month. Meeting is open to all Hawaiian Village residents.

Annual Budget year is July 1 through June 30.

- 2018/19 Budget year home valuations were \$65,745,672
- 2018/19 tax levy was .36 for our Bond and .30 for General Expenses = total .66/\$100

which brings in approx. \$430,000 to our SID to pay for our Bond payments, sewer plant maintenance, engineering, legal, insurance, trash removal, accounting, repairs to streets, mowing, and electricity for street lights and sewage plant.

Major 2018/19 Activities:

- Called our Series 2012 and 2014 bonds totaling \$2,545,000 with a weighted average interest rate of 4.56% and reissued a new Series 2019 bond at a weighted average interest rate of 3.56%
- Completed the change out of all home water meters and the conversion to Papillion Water. The SID paid for the meters and installation totaling \$86,000.
- Covered the costs of the March flooding issues: Including costs for lake pumping, emergency water from Papillion Water for 5 months up to July cutover, repairs to boat storage area, sewage lift station and plant repairs, levee engineer and evaluations, rip rap and repairs to west lake levee, grading and seeding as well as upcoming costs for repairs to south lake levee. Total cost \$165,000.

Boxtops for Platteview Central


Platteview Central collects boxtops all year-each box top from General Mills is worth \$0.10. If you would like to help support our
