Watercraft re-entry process

If the watercraft has been removed from the lake and is intent on returning the following steps must be followed to ensure elimination of any Aquatic hitchhikers. A checklist can be acquired so that all owners can be aware of what is being looked for.

- Upon return the boat must be washed at a car wash or facility that is not on site at HVLA
- A board member or representative must be contacted to inspect your craft and start the clock on quarantine. This will be a min of 5 days depending on the findings of the inspection.
- Please let the board member or representative know what lake your watercraft was in so it may be checked to see if there has been a reported contamination.
- Upon satisfaction of requirements the craft will be allowed back onto the lake.

If your craft was out for service please have a signed slip from your mechanic stating that it was not introduced to another body of water and it can be reintroduced to the lake with out the quarantine period.

All outside contractors and service craft must have an inspection and or a certificate of a steam power wash to gain access to the lake. Please make sure they are aware of these requirements when scheduling maintenance and repairs. A board member or representative will be happy to answer any questions they have.
