MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 97 OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA HELD AT 5:00 P.M. ON AUGUST 15, 2017 AT 8335 PLATTEVIEW ROAD, PAPILLION, NEBRASKA

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 97 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in an open and public session at 5:00 p.m. on August 15, 2017, at the Sarpy County Sheriff's Station, located at 8335 Platteview Road, Papillion, Nebraska, 68046.

Present at the meeting were Trustees David Barry, David Wennstedt, Jeff Warinski, and Dick Heideman. Also present was Adam Flanagan of Kuehl Capital Corporation, municipal advisors on behalf of the District; and Brian Doyle of Fullenkamp, Doyle & Jobeun, LLP, attorney on behalf of the District. Trustee Shellie Zeeb was absent.

The Clerk then publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in <u>The Papillion Times</u> on August 9, 2017, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the publicized notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the Sarpy County Clerk at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed the Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made a part hereof by this reference.

The below matters were then discussed in the following order:

The Board heard its monthly report from Urban Utilities. The month was normal. UU
also brought up if the District should consider even and odd watering days for lawn
irrigation. The Board will discuss further at future meetings. The Board also discussed
looking into getting a permanent generator for the wastewater treatment plant and a

temporary one to service the lift stations during a power outage. The Board discussed that during storm evens similar to this, there are often not enough generators available to rent in order to meet demand.

- 2. The Board then discussed its sewer rates. The Board authorized UU to update all bills including the home the City of Papillion pays. The Board's attorney will inform Papillion of the changes and seek reimbursement for the under-billed amounts going back to when the change was made.
- 3. The Board also discussed applying for security grants from the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality for upgrades to the WWTP.
- 4. Kuehl Capital Corporation reviewed updated financial statements. They reported they are monitoring bond interest rates every month and at this time it does not make financial sense to refinance the 2012 bond issue. They are recommending the same levy as the previous year.
- 5. The slide gate repair has been completed.
- 6. The Board discussed volunteer trees on the levee. It was noted that there were not too many and the Board will monitor for next spring.
- 7. The Board reviewed the two previously submitted siding bids and noted that they were unable to secure a third bid. Upon motion made by Trustee Barry and seconded by Trustee Heideman, the Board voted four (4) "aye" and zero (0) "nay" to accept the bid of \$8,800.00 form CDS.
- 8. HVLA liaison Martin Aprich gave an update on Association matters. The Association is getting new picnic tables. The Association is also updating its boat storage policies. The Association is looking at trees near the beach. He noted that zebra mussels have been found in Carter Lake and for a third time in Lake Zorinsky. The Association is looking at its policies in order to deal with the potential of zebra mussels.

The Chairman next presented the following invoices and statements to be paid out of the General Fund Account of the District:

a.) Urban Utilities, Inc. for WWTP maintenance for August Postal \$3,837.36 Service charges, emergency services, sampling, etc. (#8123).

b.) Urban Utilities, Inc. for August meter reading/invoicing, NE Dept. \$1,486.80 NE Dept. of Revenue form prep., etc. for, and permit preparation (#8124).

- c.) Warrant No. 4430 for \$122.05 made payable to Midwest Laboratories, Inc. for water testing.
- d.) Warrant No. 4431 for \$880.00 made payable to Tri-State Pumping, LLC for sludge removal and hauling from WWTP.
- e.) Warrant No. 4432 for \$9,000.00 made payable to Kuehl Capital Corporation for financial advisor/fiscal agent services for FY 2017/2018.
- f.) Warrant No. 4433 for \$98.00 made payable to Kelly R. Burns CPA for accounting services relating to bookkeeping of warrants of the District.
- g.) Warrant No. 4434 for \$15,820.00 made payable to AllTrees for storm damage remediation of downed trees/branches, grinding, removal, etc.
- h.) Warrant No. 4435 for \$447.59 made payable to the City of Omaha for waste water service with tax (quarterly).

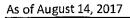
