

# **Hawaiian Village Lake-Re Entry Process**

If your watercraft has been removed from Hawaiian Village Lake, with the intent to re-enter the lake, the following steps must be taken to avoid any Aquatic hitchhikers (Zebra Mussels).

- Documentation from Gatekeeper's or a Board Member showing the date of the removal of the watercraft.
- Upon return, the boat must first show documentation that the boat has been thoroughly washed with 140+ degree hot water. Drain all lake bilge, ballast, waste water & live well, and thoroughly wash with the required 140+ degree hot water.
- Or a minimum of 14 days since the watercraft has last been in water.
- If you choose to quarantine for the 14 days, please notify a Board Member or the Gatekeeper's list for re-entry.

If your watercraft was out for service, please have a signed slip from your mechanic, stating that it was not introduced to another body of water and can be reintroduced to the lake without the required quarantined period or proof of being hot washed.

All outside contractors and service craft must have an inspection and/or a certificate of the required 140+ degree hot wash to gain access to the lake. A Board Member or Gate keeper representative will be happy to answer any further questions you may have.
