Watercraft Compliance & Safety Requirements (Updated 2026)

All HVLA Residents wishing to operate a watercraft at Hawaiian Village will need to review and comply with the following conditions:

1. All watercraft will need to have current registration and display the appropriate registration stickers
2. Watercraft must have current HVLA boating stickers indicating the residents current lot information
3. Watercraft must meet all current HVLA safety/boating covenants as approved by the residents

APPROVED CHANGES TO HAWAIIAN VILLAGE LAKE ASSOCIATION SAFETY REGULATIONS JUNE 2025

Approved Section K Boating Rules:– (2: F and G) of the Boating Rules Amended 3-11-1991 and 6-6-1997 amended changes:

- Section K. Boating Rules -2. b) All boats and personal water craft (PWC) must display the owner's lot number in a visible position on the back left and back right side of the boat (Port Quarter and Starboard Aft).
- Section K. 4. b) Boat Speed limit Is no wake 20 minutes after daily sunset time.
- 1997 Amendment- Section K. 2. g) - No boats over 18'11" (as per manufacturers hull length), will be allowed.
- 1997 Amendment – Section K. 2. g) No Pontoon boat over 22 feet 11 inches (as per manufacturers specified log length).
- 1997 Amendment – Section K. 2. g) Pontoon Maximum of 50 horsepower engine.

UPDATED SAFETY & OPERATION REQUIREMENTS (2026)

- **Maximum lake speed: 35 MPH**
- No wake when street lights are illuminated and within all coves
- Maintain minimum distance of 50 feet from docks, shorelines, and other watercraft
- Maintain 200 feet distance when towing skiers or riders and display *skier-down flag* when applicable
- One USCG-approved life jacket per person onboard (children under 12 must wear at all times)
- Navigation lights required at night
- Fire extinguisher required onboard where applicable

New residents wishing to Demo a boat may request temporary access for the watercraft from the Head of Safety or the Board President.

New and Replacement Stickers ONLY

New and Replacement stickers may be requested here: HVLA Sticker Request Form (this form will be sent to a two member team who will acknowledge receipt of your request within 24 hours. This does not mean stickers will be issued within that 24 hour period.)

New Watercraft Requests (Includes trailer where applicable)

- Name of Resident
- Current HVLA Address (Lot # if known)
- A copy of the current Registration (Include trailer if Applicable)
- Type of watercraft: Pontoon, Inboard/outboard boat, outboard boat, PWC (Jetski)

Upon review of the above. If watercraft is deemed compliant a visual inspection of the watercraft will be conducted and stickers to be provided if it meets lake covenants.


Should a watercraft be denied, notification will be provided including why the team is denying the request. Resident will have an opportunity to correct issues or provide support in support of the original request.

Replacement Stickers will need to provide the following

- Name of Resident
- Current HVLA Address (Lot # if known)
- A copy of the current Registration (Include trailer if Applicable)
- Watercraft information for sticker renewal (Year, Make, Model)

If a watercraft does not have a current (GREEN) sticker the request will be treated similarly to a new sticker request.
